Prayer:

SATURDAY: Matthew 21:16

Do you hear what these children are saying? They asked him. 'Yes', replied Jesus, 'have you never read, From the lips of children and infants You have ordained praise'?

Prayer:

Father, thank You that You have ordained perfect praise from the lips of my children.

MONDAY: Psalm 118:28-29

You are my God, and I will give thanks; You are my God, and I will exalt you. Give thanks to the LORD, for He is good; His love endures forever.

Prayer:

Father, I am so thankful that you are the Lord my God! I will always praise You and tell You how much I appreciate you. Lord, I am so thankful because You are good and You will always love me.

WEDNESDAY: Psalm 145:2-3

Every day I will bless You and praise Your name forever. Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised.

Prayer:

Lord, every day I will bless You and praise Your Name. You are a great and awesome God and worthy to be praised.

FRIDAY: Psalm 150:6

Let everything that has breath praise the Lord. Praise the Lord!
